Reporting to Tyndale's Transport Coordinator, successful candidates will be responsible for providing a safe and timely bus service for students to and from Tyndale each day.

**Current opportunities include: Part-time (2.5 hours each weekday morning and/or afternoon) and Casual work.**

Tyndale's bus services operate during school term from 6:30am to 9:00am and 2:45pm to 5:15pm, Monday to Friday. When the school requires it, additional shifts may be offered (mostly between 9.00am and 2.45pm) for conveying students to and from excursions and sporting events. There are also opportunities to cover other drivers' absences.

The ideal candidate will be reliable and have experience in driving with a Medium Rigid (MR) or Heavy Rigid (HR) licence. Candidates with a Light Rigid (LR) licence and a willingness to upgrade may be considered.

Tyndale's fleet of buses includes both mini buses and larger vehicles with a mixture of automatic and manual transmissions. Experience with a variety of vehicles would be preferred.

With just under 1,000 students from Preschool to Year 12, Tyndale Christian School has been providing Christ-centred Biblical education to families of Blacktown and surrounding suburbs for more than 50 years. All staff at Tyndale need to be Christians of Reformed/Evangelical persuasion, who are active in their own churches and wholeheartedly subscribe to the School's Educational Creed ([www.tyndale.edu.au/about-us/educational-creed/](http://www.tyndale.edu.au/about-us/educational-creed/)).

Located on a large campus in the middle of an established residential area, Tyndale is readily accessible by car and public transport.
