## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERED COURSES

Applications for enrolment must be made on the Application to Enrol – Overseas Student Form. This must be accurately completed, and **must be** accompanied by the following documents to support the application:

- Copies of Student School Reports from the previous 2 years of study, including a copy of the latest Student School Report
- A letter or Statutory Declaration from the student's current or most recent School Principal is also required if student reports do not record student behaviour or commitment to studies
- A completed Elective Subject Choices Form, if applicable (Years 9-12)
- Appropriate proof of identity and age
- Written evidence of proficiency in English as a second language
- A clear, readable photocopy or scanned copy of passport page with name, photo identification, passport number and expiry date.

Where the above documents are not in English, certified translations in English are required, with necessary costs to be met by the applicant.

An application for enrolment can only be processed when all of the above are in the hands of the Administration and Enrolment Coordinator. Applications from overseas students are processed according to established policy and procedures, and are dealt with on their merits.

Assessment procedures include an evaluation of reports from previous schools and of English language proficiency. In cases where reports are not available or are inconclusive for any reason, the school may require relevant testing of the applicant to assess the application.

### Academic Requirements

Minimum academic and English language requirements are as follows:

- Students must provide evidence of satisfactory academic performance appropriate to enter the Year level requested on the Application to Enrol – Overseas Student or offered as an alternative point of entry by the school in a Letter of Offer – Overseas Students

For Primary School:

- Evidence of application to school work and age-appropriate achievement in literacy and numeracy areas of the curriculum

For Years 8 – 12:

- A pass level or "C" grade or better for the majority of core subjects

### English Language Proficiency Requirements

Tyndale Christian School requires evidence of sufficient proficiency in English to successfully meet the curriculum demands of the enrolled course. This is a requirement under the 2007 National Code of Practice, Section D Standard 2.

Evidence of English Language Assessment must meet the requirements of the Migration Regulations where required. In the case of AL4 applicants 16 years of age or older, as of 1 April, 2004, Migration Regulations must be met. This evidence may be presented as evidence of previous study in English as the medium of instruction, or as results in an acceptable English language proficiency test.

### Acceptable Minimum Test Result for Entry into Senior Years

Where Migration Regulations do not apply, the School accepts results from the following test instruments:

Year	IELTS (or equivalent) Test
Year 10	5
Year 11	5.5
Year 12	5.5 or 6

Please Note: That if a student's language proficiency is below that outlined above, they may be required to undertake an intensive English language course before beginning mainstream studies. Students would be notified of this before the enrolment process proceeded.

Students wishing to enter the school below Year 10 level are assessed individually based on the contents of their school report and personal references, and may also be required to undertake a language proficiency test set by the School. All students will be assessed for numeracy and literacy to ensure that they are placed in the appropriate class in all their subjects.
